Athlete Funding Policy

Implemented October 2024 | Policy No. 001 | Version 2.0

This policy document is to outline WAFSC commitment to the development of our athletes and to provide funding opportunities to achieve their goals.

I. Policy Requirements

To be eligible for any funding, athletes must be nominated by their skating federation to an international competition, and the event must be listed on the ISU Calendar.

In all cases the athlete(s) applying for the funding must be:

- a current member of WAFSC
- have been a member for a total of at least **3 consecutive years** prior to applying
- attended at least **ONE** WAFSC organised competition or camp in the season prior

Athletes agree to be available to WAFSC and their sponsors for any media call ups if required.

II. ISU International Competition listed on the ISU Calendar

WAFSC will provide funding of \$100 once per season, for an international event held overseas.

III. ISU Championships Events listed on the ISU Calendar

WAFSC will provide funding annually per athlete as follows:
