

Working With Children Policy

Implemented October 2024 | Policy No. 007 | Version 2.0

The prime objective of the policy is the protection of members. A WWC Check is required if someone has an 'agreement to work' in a role undertaking 'child-related work', and no 'exemptions' apply. An agreement to work can be a written or unwritten agreement between a person and another person or an 'organisation', to carry out 'child-related work' on a 'paid', 'unpaid' or 'volunteer' basis.

It can refer to both 'child-related employment' and a 'child-related business' as defined in the *Working with Children (Screening) Act 2004*.

I. Policy Requirements

The Western Australian Figure Skating Club Inc requires all volunteers to have a current Working With Children check unless the volunteer falls into an exemption category – refer to Working With Children Check - WA. The club refers to its governing body Western Australian Ice Skating Association Inc and Ice Skating Australia Inc for the relevant policy, procedures and protocols.
